2018 CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

We invite all photographers to submit your proposal to qualify for the **Kabul Photojournalism Mentorship**, an intensive training on the practices of photojournalism to be held in Kabul in May 2018.

The weeklong event is a free professional workshop and educational resource for established and emerging Afghan photographers. The Kabul Photojournalism Mentorship is born under the initiative care of photojournalist Beb REYNOL who, with the collaborative support from the Center for Afghanistan Studies at the University of Nebraska and local valuable partners, leads the program in Kabul.

Deadline to submit: March 21st, 2018.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Open to Afghan photographers of all ages and gender
- There is no submission fee
- All submission emails must be written in English
- The event will be conducted through an interpreter Dari/Pashto

ELIGIBILITY

Before you submit:

- You must be an Afghan national residing in Kabul during the time of the event.
- You must own a digital SLR camera
- You must have your own laptop computer
- You must show at least one body of your work

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Send us a written proposal explaining why you want to participate into the event
- Submit 10 images via email to: bebreynol@deltageographic.com
- Image Size/format: jpeg, 72dpi, 1500px on the long side

- Name your files accordingly: Name_Surname_number (ie. James_Smith_1, James_Smith_2, James_Smith_3)
- Please do not send zip files
- We do not accept single image submissions
- In the Subject Line of your email, include your name and the Call for Submission for the Kabul Photojournalism Mentorship
- In the body of the email include the following information: Your Name, age, Location and Year of Photographs, brief artist statement explaining the stories behind your photographs, and a link to your website if you have one
